

RIDING THE BERKSHIRE TROLLEY

Local historian and author Gary Leveille will give an illustrated talk, Riding the Berkshire Trolley, on Thursday, March 28, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at the Lee Senior Center, 21 Crossway Street, Lee. Before introduction of the automobile, Berkshire Street Railway was one of the largest trolley systems in the country, transporting riders as they commuted to work and school and went shopping, visiting friends and touring. His interesting photographic review, focusing on South County and Lee, will help us to understand how important this line was to Berkshire County, why it disappeared, and what remains of it today.
